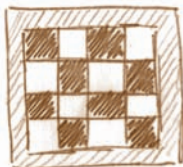
## BEGINNING SAMPLER QUILTING

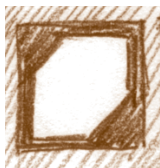
