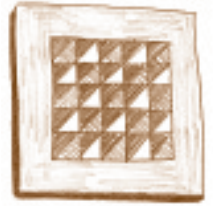

BEADED ORNAMENT INTERMEDIATE/ADVANCED**

Create an ornate beaded medallion using peyote stitch and a variety of bead embroidery stitches. The medallion includes a Czech glass button and flowers, beautiful Swarovski crystals, and an assortment of richly-colored seed beads. The finished medallion could be made into the focal point of a beaded necklace or hand bag, or it could be completed with the hanging cord provided and made into an ornament for a wall or tree. This class is best suited to students with bead embroidery experience who would like to explore new designs and techniques. Experience with peyote stitch bezels is recommended. The project is started in class and completed at home. ④

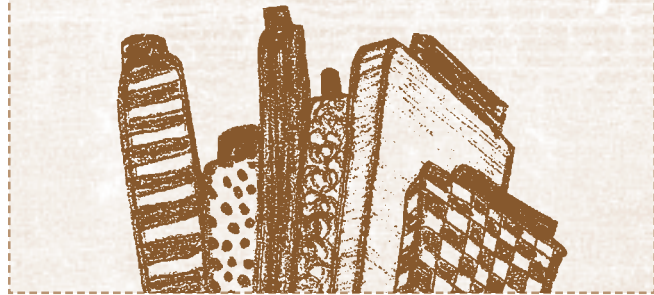
