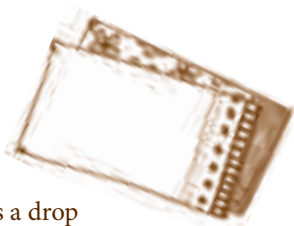


NEW CLUB: QUILT CHALLENGE CLUB

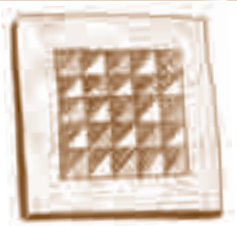
